GENERAL HARD SURFACE CLEANING

Tools Needed

· Clean Cloth or Paper Towel

Product Needed

Spic and Span® Disinfecting All-Purpose Spray and Glass Cleaner (3-in-1)

Mr. Clean® Magic Eraser






FREQUENCY OF CLEANING: Daily and as needed. Examples include spot cleaning walls, floors, counters, metal door trim; most non-porous, non-food contact hard surfaces.

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK: If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves. Mr. Clean Magic Eraser is not recommended for use on surfaces that are polished/glossy or on other easily damaged finishes. First test on an inconspicuous spot with light pressure to see if surface may scratch or dull.



STEP 1

- Clear surface by removing trash and discarding in waste receptacle.
- · Set any storage items off to the side.



 Take the 3-in-1 all-purpose cleaner spray bottle to the designated area.



• When surface is dry, replace any items generally stored on the surface.





- · If used, remove and discard single use
- Wash hands before returning to service

NOTE: For spot cleaning situations where soils or marks are not removed from hard surfaces during normal cleaning procedures, Mr. Clean Magic Eraser may be needed.



STFP 3

 Spray 3-in-1 all-purpose cleaner onto the surface holding bottle about 8 to 12 inches away from surface to avoid over-spray.

NOTE: If guests are nearby, spray in a direction that is away from guests, or spray directly onto wiping cloth or single use towel.

NOTE: Clean a small area at a time so the cleaner does not streak.



STEP 1

• Wet Mr. Clean Magic Eraser with clean water only. Never add any chemicals to Mr. Clean Magic Eraser, they are NOT needed.



STEP 2

 Test in an inconspicuous spot first to ensure surface will not be damaged.

• Move to area needing cleaning and rub surface with eraser.

STEP 4

• During usage time, eraser will shrink or become stained. Once it is no longer usable, simply discard and use a fresh new eraser for new tasks.

NOTE: Mr. Clean Magic Erasers are not to be used for smallware washing in 3-compartment sink.



STEP 4

 Using a wiping cloth or single-use towel, wipe tops, sides and underneath edges of the surface.

NOTE: Clean a small area at a time so the cleaner does not streak. If streaking occurs, use less product and/or do not buff completely dry.

NOTE: Replace wiping cloth or single use towel when it becomes dirty, or soaked with cleaner.
