

# CLEANING THE 3-COMPARTMENT SINK

## Tools Needed

- Properly Equipped Dilution Centers
- Clean Utility Bucket
- Non-Abrasive Pad
- Quat Test Strips (QT-10 or equivalent)

## Products Needed

Spic and Span®  
Floor Cleaner




Clean Quick®

Quaternary

**FREQUENCY OF CLEANING:** Daily and as needed throughout the day.


**SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK:** If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves.



### WASHING 3-COMPARTMENT SINK

#### STEP 1

- Completely drain all 3 sinks.
- Clean out all debris from the drains.
- Discard the debris in the trash container.





#### STEP 2

- Fill a clean utility bucket with Spic and Span Liquid Floor Cleaner solution from Dilution Center at the mop sink.
- Bring solution to 3 compartment sink area.
- Wet all sink surfaces with cleaning solution.
- Scrub the surfaces of all 3 sinks using a non-abrasive pad.




**NOTE: Make sure all water has completely drained from sink when finished.**



### RINSING 3-COMPARTMENT SINK

#### STEP 3

- Using the tap or overhead sprayer, rinse all 3 sink surfaces.
- Continue to rinse until there are no visible suds.
- Allow rinse water to drain completely.



### SANITIZING 3-COMPARTMENT SINK

#### STEP 4

- Turn on Quaternary Sanitizer side of the Dilution Center.



**NOTE: Ensure sanitizer is 150-400 ppm by immersing Quat Test Strip in small pan of solution before continuing (see procedure for testing quaternary sanitizer solution).**

- Wet all surfaces of the 3-compartment sink with the Quaternary Sanitizer.



#### STEP 5

- Allow excess sanitizer to drain.
- Allow 3-compartment sink to air-dry.



#### STEP 6

- If used, remove and discard disposable gloves.
- Wash hands before returning to service area.
