

BIO-HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CLEANUP PROCEDURE

Tools Needed

- Disposable towels
- Spray bottle that contains Comet® Cleaner with Bleach or another approved disinfectant
- Safety cones/signage
- Personal protective equipment (PPE): gloves, apron, mask, eye protection. Use PPE in an emergency response cleanup kit, if provided.
- 2 trash bags and ties
- Steam cleaner, if cleaning up soiled carpet and/or other soft furnishings.

Products Needed

Comet® Cleaner with Bleach



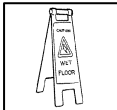
FREQUENCY: As need for an emergency response

SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK: Blood, vomit, and other bodily excretions should be treated as though they are bio-hazardous materials and the following cleanup response should be conducted in an urgent manner. Staff who conduct cleanup should be trained for proper use of personal protective equipment.



STEP 1

Put on the following personal protective equipment: gloves, mask, apron, and eye protection. Clear all individuals in the immediate area of the incident before starting cleanup.



STEP 2

Block off affected area using safety cones/signage. Cover affected area with disposable towels to absorb fluid.



STEP 3

Spray Comet® Cleaner with Bleach (or another cleaner, Spic & Span® All Purpose Cleaner and Disinfectant) over the affected area/disposable towels and beyond.

Note: Comet® Cleaner with Bleach is the preferred cleaner/disinfectant in the Procter & Gamble Professional program; however, the bleach in the product may damage some surfaces so another cleaner and disinfection process should be used for these types of surfaces. Spot test a small area before applying Comet Cleaner® with Bleach to soiled surface to ensure product does not adversely impact surface. If product discolors surface, use Spic & Span® All Purpose Cleaner and Disinfectant as cleaner and then heat disinfection process (Step 5).



STEP 4

Using the disposable towels cleanup soil and put into one of the disposal bags. Tie bag shut once soil has been removed from the incident area.



STEP 5

Thoroughly spray Comet® Cleaner with Bleach over the affected area and beyond and allow for at least a 10 minute surface/cleaner contact time.

Note: Carpet and soft furnishing should be disinfected via steam cleaning at greater than or equal to 158° F for 5 minutes of 212° F for 1 minute. Do not use Comet® Cleaner with Bleach on these items.



STEP 6

Use disposable wiping clothes to wipe up all residual disinfectant and then discard in second red biohazard bag.

Note: If affected surface is a food contact surface, it should then be rinsed with water and sanitized with an approved food contacting surface sanitizing solution (i.e. Clean Quick Sanitizer).



STEP 7

Place all items in the second bag. This includes all PPE and disposable gloves. Tie bag shut and dispose of bag in accordance with local regulations.



STEP 8

Thoroughly wash hands according to hand washing procedure.
