

# HOTEL GUEST BEDROOM CLEANING

## Tools Needed

- Cleaning Towels for Mirrors and Glass
- Cleaning Towels for Furniture
- Air Pump (optional)

**FREQUENCY OF CLEANING:** After every occupancy.

**SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK:** If sensitivity to cleaning solutions is a concern, wear disposable gloves. For faster application of fabric refresher, use the air pump.



### MIRRORS, GLASS, AND FURNITURE STEP 1

- Spray 3-in-1 all purpose spray and glass cleaner directly on surfaces to be cleaned.



- Wipe with clean towel.

**NOTE:** If streaking occurs, use less product and/or do not buff completely dry. Use a separate towel when cleaning glass and mirrors.




### TVS, DOORS AND WINDOW FRAMES, PLANTS AND OTHER HARD-TO-REACH OR CLEAN SURFACES

#### STEP 2

- Wipe surface with Swiffer dusting cloth.

**NOTE:** Swiffer dusting cloths must be used on dry surfaces. Do not spray anything on Swiffer dusting cloth.



- Attach Swiffer cloth to sweeper for hard-to-reach surfaces.

**NOTE:** Be sure to use both sides of Swiffer dusting cloth. Use one dusting cloth to clean 16 rooms, 8 rooms per side.



### NON-SMOKING ROOM ODOR TREATMENT STEP 3A

- Lightly spray Febreze fabric refresher on draperies, bedspreads, furniture cushions and carpet.
- When the fabric dries, odors disappear.
- For problem odors, use a little extra Febreze fabric refresher.



### SMOKING ROOM ODOR TREATMENT STEP 3B

- Spray Febreze fabric refresher on draperies, bedspreads, furniture cushions and carpet until lightly damp.
- Spray air conditioner/heater intake vents (2–3 sprays) while the unit is running.
- Spray lamp shades (1–2 sprays).
- Spray unused bathroom towels (1–2 sprays).
- When the fabric dries, odors disappear.

**NOTE:** Febreze fabric refresher eliminates odors trapped in fabrics. Febreze is not a perfume cover-up. As the fabric dries, fabric and Febreze odors disappear. The odors won't come back, leaving the fabric odor-free.

**Febreze is safe on virtually all fabrics. It does not yellow, tarnish or build up over time. Always test on a hidden area of fabric.**
