

# TRASH CONTAINERS (NON-CUSTOMER AREAS)

## Tools Needed

- Disposable Gloves
- Non-food Contact Brush
- Non-food Contact Scouring Pad

## Product Needed

Comet®  
Cleaner  
with Bleach




**FREQUENCY OF CLEANING:** Once a day or as needed.

**SPECIAL DIRECTIONS FOR THIS TASK:** Wear disposable gloves to help minimize contact with germs.




**NOTE:** Put on disposable gloves.




### STEP 1

- Empty all trash containers one at a time by removing the trash bag.
- Dispose of trash bags properly.
- Make sure liquids that may be in the trash bags do not drip onto the floor and cause a possible wet floor hazard.




### STEP 2

- Take trash container to mop sink area.



### STEP 3

- Spray cleaner with bleach around the inside and outside of container.




### STEP 4

- Scrub trash container inside and out with non-food contact brush or scouring pad.




### STEP 5

- Rinse with water and empty into the mop sink.



### STEP 6

- Allow trash container to air-dry.
- Place new trash bag in the container.
- Place container back into proper location.



### STEP 7

- Remove and discard disposable gloves.



- Wash hands before returning to service area.
